

DCP IN SUMMARY

1. Private cloud storage available on multiple platforms & devices: any web browsers / iOS / Android Apps
2. Basic Apps include:
 - Dashboard
 - Files
 - Photos (Gallery)
 - Talk (text chat & video conferencing)
 - Tasks
 - Activity
3. Desktop Synchronization Client – system requirements:
 - Windows: 7 and above.
 - MAC: macOS 10.12+ (64-bit only)

Tips:

- use as dissemination tool to send / update latest files / information to other users directly & instantly to their devices, otherwise, to commonly shared folder (sub folder)
 - use as auto backup agent to backup files / images / data to DCP (off-site backup) to mitigate risks of fire, flood, theft, hardware failure, sabotage (with the right setting) and as recovery & restoration source for deleted files & older versions.
4. WebDAV available for Windows Files Explorer configuration.
 5. Create unlimited users.
 6. Create group (users grouping)
 7. Create group folder (users access control)
 8. File sharing with internal & external parties. – allow or disallow editing & resharing, set expiration date & add notes to recipient.
 9. Folder sharing with internal & external parties – allow or disallow editing, creating, deleting, resharing, set expiration date & add notes to recipient.




10. Folder sharing in **link format** (especially to external party) – read only, allow or disallow upload & editing, files drop (upload only), hide download, **password protect**, set expiration date & add notes to recipient. (use this as means of receiving & delivering bulk softcopy files)
11. Use “Talk” to text message or video conference with other DCP users
12. Use “Tasks” to plan, monitor & manage tasks – also assign or share created tasks with team members to keep members updated or for team monitoring & management.
13. Use “Activity” to trace back any suspicious activities.
14. Use “Photos” to organize all your images & videos at one place.

Conclusion

Make DCP the Central Cloud Hub of the organization to increase productivity, manage files & data, for off-site backup, as well as collaboration platform with internal and external parties.
